


The Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time, June, 21st 2020.



Today is the twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time in the Liturgical Calendar. Ordinary Time takes its name from the fact that the weeks are numbered i.e. first, second etc. During Ordinary Time, the emphasis in the Mass and the Church's daily prayer is on Christ's teaching and His life among His disciples.

Second Reading: Romans 5:12-15 The gift considerably outweighed the fall.

Gospel: Matthew 10:26-33 Do not be afraid
