Today is the thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time in the Liturgical Calendar. Ordinary Time takes its name from the fact that the weeks are numbered using the ordinal numbers i.e. first, second etc. During Ordinary Time, the emphasis in the Mass and the Church's daily prayer is on Christ's teaching and His life among His disciples.

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 88:2-19 **Response:** I will sing for ever of Your love, O Lord.

Second Reading: Romans 6:3-11 When we were baptised we went into the tomb with Christ.

Gospel: Matthew 10:37-42 Anyone who welcomes you, welcomes me.
