


Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, 12th July, 2020.



Today is the fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time in the Liturgical Calendar. Ordinary Time takes its name from the fact that the weeks are numbered using the ordinal numbers i.e. first, second etc. During Ordinary Time, the emphasis in the Mass and the Church's daily prayer is on Christ's teaching and His life among His disciples.

Mass Readings for today.

First Reading: Isaiah 55:10-11 The rain makes the earth give growth.

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 64:10-14 **Response** Some seed fell into rich soil, and produced its crop.

Second Reading: Romans 8:18-23 The whole creation is waiting for God to reveal His sons

Gospel: Matthew 13:1-23 A sower went out to sow his seeds.
